(France) **Cuvée Jean Paul Gascogne Blanc de Blancs Demi Sec**

Fresh, smooth and well balanced, making this an uncomplicated easy-drinking medium dry white wine of character.

(Italy) **Mirabello – Pinot Grigio Rose**

A dry, fresh and fruity rose with delicate aromas of red berries.

Crisp and lively on the palate with good intensity of ripe berry and red cherry fruit.

Ca' di Ponti – Nero d'Avola (Italy)

Bright and lifted Shiraz with aromas of summer fruit pudding, mulberry and black pepper. The palate offers notes of vanilla and chocolate, combining elegance and length on the finish.

Elegant berry fruit aromas backed with a hint of cedar and spice, soft supple tannins marrying into the cherry fruit flavours result in a wine that is rich and smooth.
